About NCI Training

With an emphasis on early intervention and prevention, Non-Violent Crisis Intervention educates on best managing a crisis during all levels of escalation, from early anxiety cues up to physical violence.

NCI Training is broken down into 10 units that focus on:

- Organizational models in Crisis Development and Verbal Escalation
- Verbal, Non-verbal and Para-verbal communication skills
- Decision Making, Therapeutic Rapport and Postvention approaches
- Managing physical risk behavior through disengagement and/or holding skills
